

Group Visits to the T.rex Discovery Centre

Get your group off the regular route and enjoy a prehistoric adventure. Visit the T.rex Discovery Centre in Eastend, SK.

Eastend is a little treasure nestled into the eastern portion of the Cypress Hills, within one of North America's richest fossil deposit areas. The T.rex Discovery Centre is located right in Eastend- south of the #1 Highway just 115 km from Maple Creek, 140 km from Swift Current and 100km from the Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park.

Hours of Operation: 10:00am to 6:00pm

Open seasonally - Victoria Day long weekend to Labour Day .

Admission by donation. Suggested donation is \$5/ Adult, \$2/ Child, \$10/Family.

What to expect:

- Scotty the T.rex - Canada's most complete (and one of the world's largest) T.rex skeletons, along with many other fossils from Saskatchewan's exciting palaeontological history.
- *Dinosaur Hunters*, playing every half hour in the Canada Discovery Theatre documenting the discovery and excavation of Scotty the T.rex.
- Guided tours by friendly, knowledgeable staff.
- Drop-in programs for children such as excavating a fossil or painting T.rex tooth.
- Fossil Research Station laboratory. You may even see a palaeontologist at work.
- The Discovery Shop full of dinosaur and Saskatchewan themed items.
- Picnic and outdoor play area overlooking the spectacular view of the Frenchman River valley.
- Large public and bus parking lot.
- Eastend is also home to the Eastend Historical Museum, many art studios and a new outdoor pool with waterslides.
